Canadian Government Scholarship

The Royal Civil Service Commission is pleased to announce Canadian Government Scholarship for eligible and interested civil servants to pursue diploma, post-graduate certificate and Master's degree at a college, technical or vocational institute or university in Canada. The application portal will be open from **January to March 2020**.

The scholarship is open to students from all academic disciplines, for programs of up to two years duration. To be considered for a scholarship, the candidate must first apply for admission to pursue program (of one's choice) at Canadian institutes/ universities. The Canadian institutes will then apply for the scholarship on behalf of the student depending upon the quality of application. Institutions whose applications are successful will receive a contribution agreement for the administration and disbursement of scholarships to the recipients.

That it is open scholarship where candidates are required to explore universities and complete application proceedings like endeavor scholarships, the interested civil servants fulfilling eligibility criteria as per BCSR 2018 are asked to seek advice from respective HR office for course relevance prior to initiating application processes.

Note: The study leave for successful candidates is subject to course approval by the RCSC. In addition, candidates are advised to visit the links given below to know more about the scholarship modality and other details.
